PANDEMIC EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE FUNDS



PEAF is non-recurring short-term benefits. It may be received no more than four times and must be for different emergency situations.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Aanijimaadizing client (must meet 477 eligibility requirements)
- Be a family with children living in the home
- Do not have to be TANF eligible
- Expenses must be related to the pandemic or lowered family income

Expenses may include but are not limited to the following:

- Back to school expenses (Early Head Start to college)
 - Proof of custody
 - School verification
 - \$300 for every child age 10 and under
 - \$400 for every child over the age of 10
 - Receipts must be turned in to your case manager within 30 days- failure to submit will result in suspension for 90 days.
- Other Expenses
 - Rent
 - Mortgage
 - Utilities

Requests for specific bills/expenses will be vendor paid by check. A W-9 from the vendor will be required. Checks take up to 10 days after all documentation is received.
