



# FAST TRACK

## ONE-TIME EMERGENCY RENTAL ASSISTANCE

Aanjibimaadizing has received a limited amount of funding to provide a one-time payment to cover past due rent or rental utilities.

### THIS IS 1-TIME FUNDING

It cannot be used for current or upcoming payments.

It can only be requested ONCE and must be an amount that is PAST DUE.

This funding has a short timeline and will end on September 30th, 2023 - or before, if funding is expended.

### ELIGIBILITY

- Owe back rent or rental utility payments
- Be a Mille Lacs Band Member, MLBO 1st Descendant, or have a MLBO child living in the house
- Be at imminent risk of homelessness and live in the state of Minnesota
- Have exhausted other resources, and no remaining resources to resolve the crisis
- Be low income (The household is at or below 200% of federal poverty guidelines)
- Be employed, likely to be employed with sustainable income within 3 months, or connected to other income (SSI, etc.) that will likely be sustainable within 3 months

### HOW TO APPLY

Please note: The application cannot be accessed from the internet or wi-fi that is on the MLBO Government network.

Documentation needed will include:

- Complete application (including email address and signatures from all household members 18 and over)
- Tribal Identification or other government issued photo ID (State ID, License or Passport)
- Verification of gross household income of all adults and the number of individuals in the household for the past 2 months (Per Cap must be reported as income)
- Current rental lease that includes address of rental unit. The lease should list all household members.
- Total amount rental and/or utility arrears owed
- Verification of past due rent or utilities (eviction notice, past due bill, shut off notice)
- Contact information (including phone number or email) for the organization to be paid

You may be contacted to provide custody paperwork, school verification forms, or other documentation as needed. Aanjibimaadizing will contact the organizations to be paid to complete the landlord verification form and/or W9. No payments may be made until application is complete, all items are received, and documents are signed.
